2. When I serve, am I seeking to exalt Jesus and build up others, or am I subtly seeking recognition, control, or validation for myself?  
(*What does the "manner of spirit" behind my service reveal about my heart?*)

3. How am I intentionally using the gifts God has entrusted to me (motivational, ministry, or otherwise) for the profit of the whole body?  
(*If my gifts were removed, what part of the body would feel the loss?*)

4. Am I attentive and willing to join the Holy Spirit when He desires to work through me, even when it stretches my comfort, timing, or expectations?  
(*Am I merely watching God work, or positioning myself as a ready conduit for His purposes?*)
